The Japanese Society of Digital Pathology is a research group started in 1999, comprising of pathologists, clinical technologists, and vendors of optical equipment, communication and information systems. In recent years, the use of WSI (Whole Slide Imaging) systems for high-resolution digitization of pathology slides and Artificial Intelligence (AI) has been promoted in the field of pathology diagnosis, and is maturing as a technology that can be implemented in medicine. On the other hand, a survey showed that only one in eight pathologists in Japan uses WSI for pathological diagnosis, and the Society is expected to play a leading role in the future diffusion of pathology digitalization in Japan.

The main theme of this year's General Meeting is The "Glocalization" of Digital Pathology. Glocalization is a term coined to describe considering both global and local perspectives simultaneously. Pathological diagnosis is both global and universal, but at the same time it must be applied to the local context – ultimately, the unique person, the patient, who is not interchangeable. We hope to contribute to patients living locally while using digital pathology technology that can be applied on a global scale. There are many challenges, but we would like to think together with you about how we can solve real problems through the depth and breadth of digital pathology.

This year's event will be held on site, as it was last year. We hope that you will enjoy the exchange of information and the opportunity to interact at the conference venue, and that you will have a meaningful time at this year's conference.

Access to Meio University from Naha Airport

- < By public transportation >
 - 1. From Naha Airport, take a Highway Bus to the Nago Bus Terminal.

Exit the Naha Airport arrival lobby, go to the bus stop on the left, and take "Highway Bus No. 111" or "117", "YKB", or "Airport Limousine Bus D" or "Airport Limousine Bus E". (From Naha Airport to the Nago Bus Terminal, it takes about 1 hour and 45 minutes.)

- 2. From the Nago Bus Terminal to Meio University
- By free shuttle

We are planning to operate a free shuttle bus service between Nago Bus Terminal and the meeting venue.

·By bus

From the Nago Bus Terminal, take bus No. 70 or 76, get off at the bus stop "Meio University entrance," and walk to the venue (it is about an 18-minute ride and 15-minute walk). Please note that the buses are limited (5 buses per day).

·By taxi

If you take a taxi from the Nago Bus Terminal to Meio University, it is about a 10-minute ride, and the fare is about JPY 880–900.

< By rental car >

There are many car rental companies near Naha Airport. Take the Okinawa Expressway to get to Meio University. It takes about 2 hours from Naha Airport to Meio University.

 - Power supply: AC100 V, 60Hz

 - Booth locations are to be arranged by the Secretariat




Fig. 1 Image of display stand

 - The exhibition hall layout may change depending on the number of companies applying.




Fig. 2 Image of exhibition hall layout
